From The Pulpit

Europe is an interesting continent. Every time I visit, it never fails to impress me with its multi-dimensional experiences. On my last trip I had a lot of interesting encounters. One of them occurred in **Bamberg, Germany**. Bamberg is a gorgeous Franconia town famous for its medieval atmosphere and its breweries. I enthusiastically partook of both. When you are in Bamberg, if you walk all the way up the *Judenstrasse* (Jewish St.), you will end up at the entrance to *Schlenkerla*, arguably the most famous local brewery. *Schlenkerla* produces a unique smoked beer. That is why it is a place of pilgrimage for so many tourists from all over the world.

While inside the *Schlenkerla* beer hall I struck a conversation with some locals. Very nice and hospitable people! The discussion somehow switched to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. My new friends expressed an idea I heard so many times before: these armed to the teeth Israelis just wouldn't let these poor Palestinians be *etc.*. In response I pointed out a very simple fact. The overwhelming majority of the Israelis do think that the Palestinian State ought to exist. Yet the majority of the Palestinians do think that the Jewish State shouldn't exist at all. Then how can you expect Israel to seek compromise with someone who believes that the Jewish State should be erased from the map? The Germans agreed with me.

This teaches us an important lesson. While in America the above paragraph would merely constitute preaching to the choir, in Europe things are not so obvious. The Arab world did do a good public relations job on the European continent. Many Europeans are aware of the Palestinian point of view. However, we, the Jews, have not done such a good job. We did not promote our point of view to a sufficient extent. I happen to think that we should do that, considering the fact that Europe continues to play a vital role in the world.

Europeans are very open minded people. They often express opinions critical of Israel merely because we fail to present our case properly. It is too easy to do it in the US, and it is more competitive out in Europe. So let us go out and compete for people's minds out there! It's about time.

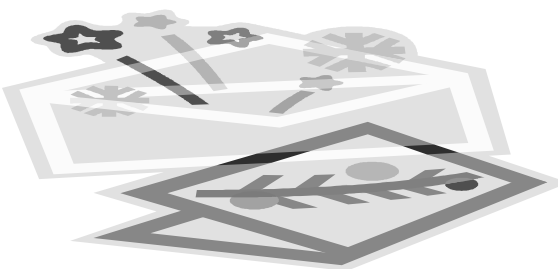
